The Lincoln Community Foundation Board welcomes your interest!

We've provided the subsequent documents for use as a guide in the administration of the Foundation Board of Directors. Below is a brief overview of our history and purpose.

The LCF was established in 2003 in partnership with the City of Lincoln. We are a nonprofit 501(c)(3) organization whose charge is to "enhance the quality of life for the Lincoln community through funding of community based organization."

The City of Lincoln gifted LCF with an endowment, initiating an investment fund to be used toward awarding grants to local nonprofit groups. The purpose of LCF is to maintain and grow this fund, enabling LCF to achieve its mission. Nonprofit organizations can submit a detailed grant application to be reviewed by committee. If the application meets our goals and passes committee, the Board then votes to determine which projects will receive grant monies. Money is granted for use only within the Western Placer Unified School District boundaries.

To be able to continue granting monies we seek tax deductible contributions by various methods. Contributions of cash, stocks, bonds, retirement accounts, real estate or other assets are accepted and appreciated.
